St. Petersburg-Clearwater International Airport's new look will be completed in 2010, featuring a new tropical design and improved customer amenities.

The \$22 million terminal renovation, which includes federal stimulus funding, allowed the airport to seamlessly phase together projects to create a whole new look for a terminal built in 12 phases over 50 years. Additionally, energy efficient improvements will save in operating costs. New interior design including carpet, tile, wall coverings, seating, ticket counters, combined with infrastructure improvements and our first passenger loading bridges, will change the look and functionality of the terminal.

St. Petersburg-Clearwater International Airport (PIE) provides easy and convenient access to low-cost airline service throughout the Midwest, Northeast, Southeast, Canada, and the Caribbean. Even with a hectic year of construction activity and a challenging economy, PIE's passenger's numbers held steady in 2009, up 4% from a year ago through November. Allegiant Air's non-stop, low-cost flights to 20 destinations are very popular with locals and

visitors to Tampa Bay. Recently, Allegiant Air announced the addition of Bangor, Maine, one of the most requested cities in Tampa Bay, with convenient access from Bangor International Airport to cities in Maine and the New England - Atlantic Canada region. In total, PIE currently has 7 airlines flying to 28 non-stop destinations.

Looking forward to new services in 2010, Vision Airlines will begin operating nonstop flights from PIE to Gulfport-Biloxi, MS beginning January 8th. Additionally, Locair added non-stop flights to the Bahamas in December.
