Southwest Florida International Airport (Fort Myers)

The Denver-based Frontier Airlines announced its non-stop flights from Denver International Airport to Fort Myers. The airline will also increase trips between DIA and Tampa International Airport. 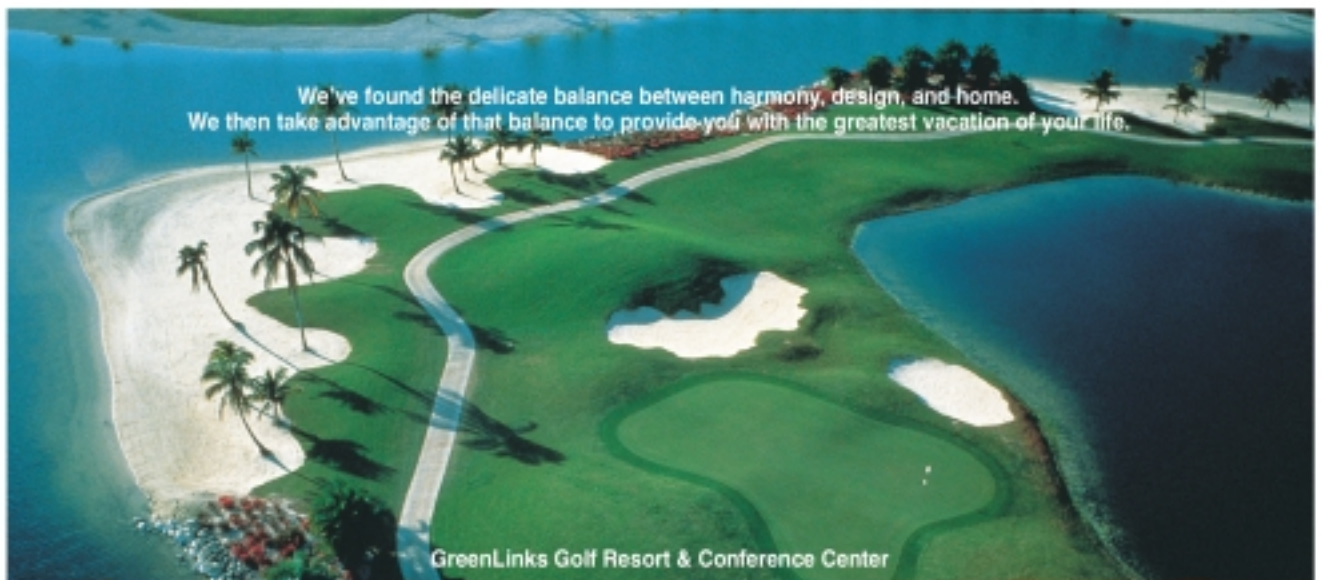

Southwest Airlines to serve Northwest Florida

Southwest Airlines made a recent announcement that beginning May 2010 they will service the new Panama City International Airport. Delta Airlines to expand service in Key West

Delta Airlines plans to offer expanded service between Key West International Airport and its Atlanta hub beginning Dec. 17 with the addition of daily mainline jet service. Once-daily round-trip flights are scheduled on Delta's 124-seat Boeing 737-700 jets.

The new flights are scheduled to depart Atlanta at 9:55 a.m. each day, arriving at Key West at noon. Key West to Atlanta jet flights are scheduled to depart at 12:45 p.m., arriving at Atlanta at 2:50 p.m.

Direct Air Expands into Melbourne

Starting in February 2010, U.S. Airways will add three daily flights to its Charlotte, N.C., hub from Melbourne International Airport and fast-growing charter airline Direct Air will begin service to Washington Dulles, Niagara Falls, N.Y. and Punta Gorda, Fla. Direct Air's twice-daily service to Dulles will operate every day except Tuesdays. Service to Niagara Falls and Punta Gorda be twice a week. These new carriers will add 74 flights per week to and from Melbourne, supplementing current service provided by Delta Air Lines, Delta Connections and Baer Air. www.mlair.com
