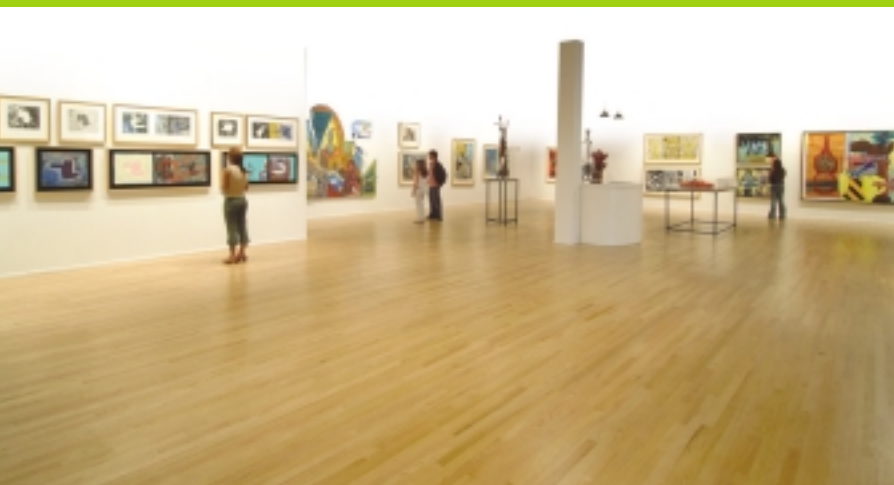


# SELBY GALLERY



Since 1986, Selby Gallery has brought internationally renowned artists and their cutting edge work to Sarasota.

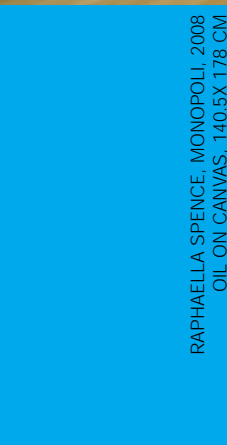

**[Jan. 15 - Feb. 16, 2010]** In the third of a series, Selby Gallery presents **REAL(ists)**. A non-gender specific exhibition that takes visitors on a visual journey from the objectivity of photorealism to the subjectivity of paintings and sculpture that morph reality into highly expressive and sometimes bizarre imagery.

**[Feb. 26 - Mar. 31, 2010]** **Perestroika (n) Restructuring: The Glass Sculpture of Kathleen Mulcahy, Ron Desmett and Martin Prekop.** Fine art glass is generally perceived as beautiful vessels designed to be seen rather than used. This exhibition will demonstrate that glass is now being used to create sculpture and installations that utilize the unique appearance of the medium and how it can create mind-boggling installations.
