The Palm Beach Season

Palm Beach is renowned for its sun, sand and social season, which glitters to life in the winter months with charity galas, cultural soirees and art exhibit preview parties.

Contemporary and fine art fairs, rows of renowned antique shops and extraordinary museums all finely illustrate why the Palm Beaches have long been the premier tourism and cultural destination for informed travelers.

During January and February at the Palm Beach County Convention Center, collectors and art enthusiasts have the opportunity to view international treasures, eclectic jewelry and artwork from all periods and disciplines. Three internationally renowned art and antique fairs anchor the Art and Antique Season in the Palm Beaches.

Art Palm Beach, a modern and contemporary art fair, is January 15-19 and hosts over 74 international galleries presenting contemporary art, photography, video, installation art, sculpture and design from over 1,500 artists. Art Palm Beach will feature interactive sections, project rooms, a

video lounge and an art internet café. Hours are 12-7:00 p.m. One-day passes are \$15 and multi-day passes are \$20. Visit www.artpalmbeach.com.

February hosts the "crown jewel" of American art fairs, the American International Fine Art Fair. AIFAF is the only American fair accorded five stars by The Art Newspaper. The fair will host more than 80 prominent exhibitors from more than 13 countries representing disciplines of fine art from classical antiquity to contemporary. This year will feature a new series of special after-hours events at select cultural destinations to give collectors, dealers, museum experts and art enthusiasts the opportunity to mingle and party after the fair closes each evening. Hours are February 3-8, 12-7:00 p.m. Admission costs range between \$10 for students to a multi-day pass with hard-cover catalog for \$55. Please visit www.ifae.com.

The Palm Beach Jewelry, Art & Antique Show, February 12-16, is anticipated to attract more than 50,000 visitors again this year. The fair has a history of presenting top-level inventory from highly-renowned international dealers with premium examples of artwork, furniture, ceramics, jewels and watches being presented by over two hundred international exhibitors. According to Antiques Roadshow Insider, Southern Florida and Palm Beach County is "known for the eclectic Palm Beach Jewelry, Art & Antique Show." Complementing the art, antique and jewelry fairs is a top-tier offering of museums, art galleries and antique/vintage store experiences.

The Boca Raton Museum of Art features an exciting permanent collection and presents changing exhibits of national and international importance throughout the year.


The Morikami Museum and Japanese Gardens, has been a center for Japanese arts and culture in South Florida since opening in 1977. They host the world's largest collection of Japanese gardens outside of Japan and feature rotating exhibits, tea ceremonies and Japanese traditional festivals several times a year.

Downtown Delray Beach's Gallery District offers a gallery walk every Friday night from 7-10:00 p.m. Sip wine while viewing local and renowned art at more than ten galleries. Old School Square Cultural Art Center is in the heart of charming downtown Delray Beach and features the Crest Theatre, the Cornell Museum and a large outdoor entertainment pavilion.

The Armory Art Center in West Palm Beach is an artist work and showcase facility that hosts a number of exceptional exhibits.

Antique Row in the Art & Design District in West Palm Beach is where the world's best interior designers shop. It's home to more than 40 antique shops offering an impressive selection of 17th to 20th century antiques, fine and decorative arts, period deco and modern furnishings.

Norton Museum of Art in West Palm Beach is one of the largest museums in the Southeast. The Museum is internationally known for its distinguished permanent collection and features acclaimed visiting exhibits.
