If luxuriating in an area's

stylish atmosphere, which includes beautiful pedestrian walks with shops, art galleries and restaurants, along with palatial homes surrounded by tropical landscaping, appeals to your inner traveler - Naples is your destination!



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The splendor of Naples begins with its powdery, white sand beaches, which extend from the parks and public beaches near downtown Naples to more secluded seaside havens to the north.

Naples' beaches are regarded among the finest in the world, and offer visitors a tranquil and beautiful escape from everyday life. Barefoot Beach Preserve, just north of downtown Naples, appears in the top ten of Dr. Beach's 2006 America's Best Beaches list issued every year by coastal researcher Dr. Stephen Leatherman. Boardwalks allow visitors to cross the dunes to the beach throughout the downtown Naples area, offering public access for those not staying at a Gulf-front resort.

More families are discovering the delights of Naples. Naples Zoo at Caribbean Gardens is fully accredited by the national Association of Zoos & Aquariums (AZA) and offers unique shows and interactive animal experiences including the Meet the Keeper series, the multimedia Planet Predator show, and a boat ride past the zoo's primate islands where the residents live cage-free.

The Sun-n-Fun Lagoon water park at North Collier Regional Park offers huge water slides and a lazy river for tubing through the park.

With nearly 90 golf courses in the greater Naples area, the region is frequently either first or second in USA rankings of most golf holes per capita. Many area resorts either own their own private courses or have affiliate relationships with area private clubs. Entry onto area courses may be obtained through stays at resorts that have their own courses, including LaPlaya Beach & Golf Resort, Naples Grand Beach Resort, Edgewater Beach Hotel, Marco Beach Ocean Resort, The Ritz-Carlton Resorts of Naples (yes, there are two - The Ritz-Carlton, Naples and The Ritz-Carlton Golf Resort, Naples), The Naples Beach Hotel & Golf Club, the Marco Island Marriott, GreenLinks Golf Resort and the Quality Inn & Suites Golf Resort.

Third Street South and the Avenues, Naples' business district at the turn of the century and now a recognized historic district, offers premier shopping and dining. The area includes Gallery Row, a collection of distinctive art galleries located near

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the intersection of Broad Street and Third Street South. The district even has its own Street Concierge booth which is staffed daily with friendly helpers eager to offer advice and directions.

Bayfront is Naples' newest shopping, dining, arts and entertainment center. Colorful Mediterranean architecture houses a collection of upscale shops complemented by restaurants, bars, fine art galleries and the newly renovated Bayfront Inn on Fifth, all overlooking the Gordon River.

Culture abounds in Naples. From theatre to dance, to its 100+ art galleries and numerous fascinating museums, greater Naples is recognized internationally as a destination for the culturally minded.

Naples was named the #1 Small Art Town in America in 2005 by author and art critic John Villani; and Naples was named one of the "Top 25 Cities for Art" in the June 2008 issue of American Style magazine.

The Naples Museum of Art houses 15 galleries with both permanent and traveling exhibits. The Philharmonic Center for the Arts brings the finest in music, theater and dance to Naples each season, including the Naples Philharmonic Orchestra and the Miami City Ballet. The Naples Players, recognized as one of the top community theater groups in the country, perform throughout the year at downtown Naples' Sugden Theatre. Theater Zone brings Broadway style professional productions to town. Gulfshore Playhouse brings quality entertainment to the Norris Center in downtown Naples. Opera Naples has an increasing number of performances.

The area's many bays, canals and rivers provide a network of waterways for cruising, kayaking, canoeing, fishing or relaxing. Boat tours are also a popular way to peek into the luxurious lifestyle of Naples' wealthier residents, with elegant estates lining the waters of Naples Bay.

Many professional fishing guides offer private or group boat charters that allow anglers to experience the unique thrill of fishing for tarpon, snook, redfish, permit, snapper, grouper and other popular game fish species.

Dining! Seafood has been a decades-long love affair at the **Dock**, an open-air restaurant overlooking Naples Bay. Here, they prepare the freshest fish with Caribbean and Latin influences; the menu also offers tasty salads and sand-

wiches, and tempting beef, poultry and pasta dishes, as well as innovative daily specials and a surprisingly affordable wine list. The ambiance of the Dock is as compelling as its food. The Dock is a little piece of Naples' history - in fact, for lots of locals and visitors, they're practically part of the family. They give people what Naples is all about - Bay views, great food and a laid-back attitude.

Dining! Overlooking the Gordon River, **Riverwalk** is part of Naples' past. Tin City, the shopping area in which it's located, was built in the 1940's as a working dock and the site of Doxsee's Clam Factory. Today, planked floors, maritime artifacts, and handrails and doors carved by artist Clint Beatty echo this rich history.

True to this tradition are the Gulf Coast preparations of the freshest fish and blue-ribbon fruits and vegetables that are the cornerstone of this restaurant's fare. The menu brims with innovative interpretations of salads, sandwiches, pastas and steaks, as well as seafood entrees that are grilled, seared, roasted, barbecued or fried, all complemented by daily features and tropical cocktails. Tourists and residents alike make Riverwalk a regular getaway from the everyday.
